



Figure 1 Alignment of the current sheep linkage map (v 4.2) with the goat linkage map (Schibler *et al.*, 1998).

Locus codes, marker names and position details are only given for markers that have been mapped by linkage analysis in both sheep and goats. Marker names are indicated beside sheep chromosomes and locus codes are given beside goat chromosomes. Lines are used to indicate the positions of all markers that have been mapped in sheep and goat. *Cattle markers are indicated by italics*, goat markers are underlined and sheep markers are indicated in normal text.

ESTs are prefaced by a ~, anonymous loci are prefaced by a \.

Loci that have been linkage mapped, but not on the IMF, are indicated either at the bottom of the appropriate chromosome or at their estimated position on the chromosome. Red (thick) lines between chromosomes are used to indicate loci that are on the sheep framework map.
